**GUIDELINE**

**Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)**

This guideline applies to all FoH students enrolled in programs that require a valid CPR Basic Life Support (BLS) or HCP certificate or equivalent. Credentials must be obtained from a first aid provider that follows the current Canadian CPR guidelines using one of the following curriculum providers: Heart & Stroke Foundation of Canada, St. John Ambulance, Lifesaving Society, or Canadian Red Cross.

**Note:** HCAP students require CPR Level C only

**Fit Testing (N95 Respirator Mask)**

This Guideline applies to all students enrolled in FoH programs with a practice component.

**PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES**

1. It is the student's responsibility to renew the CPR-BLS certificate or equivalent annually.
2. It is the student's responsibility to be fit tested annually with a medical grade N95 Respirator Mask.
3. Students must present their valid certificate to their practice instructor at the beginning of each practice course. A copy may also be required in the student's e-Portfolio.



4. Students who cannot provide evidence of current certification will not be allowed to attend practice experiences until proof of certification can be provided.
